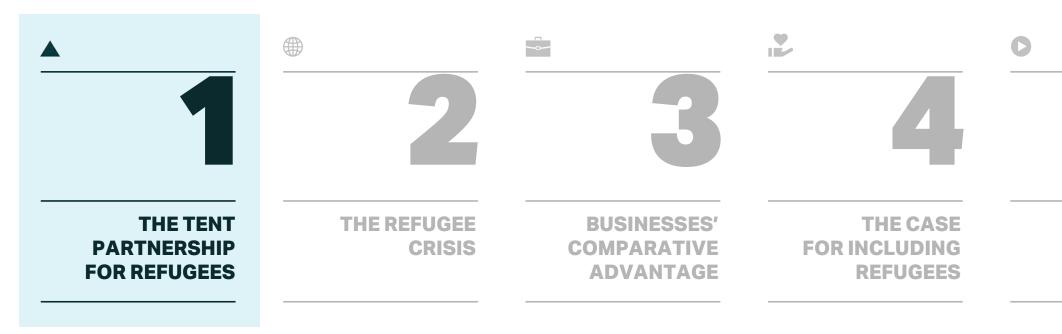

Hamdi Ulukaya launched Chobani in 2007. The company became one of the fastest to reach \$1 billion USD in annual sales.

Hamdi made proactive efforts to hire refugees since launching Chobani. Refugees now account for 20–30% of the company's workforce. Hamdi is a Kurdish-Turkish businessman & entrepreneur who immigrated to the United States. He has been named one of TIME's 100 Most Influential People in the World for his innovative approach to business and work on the refugee crisis.

Tent mobilizes the business community to improve the lives and livelihoods of 30 million refugees forcibly displaced from their home countries

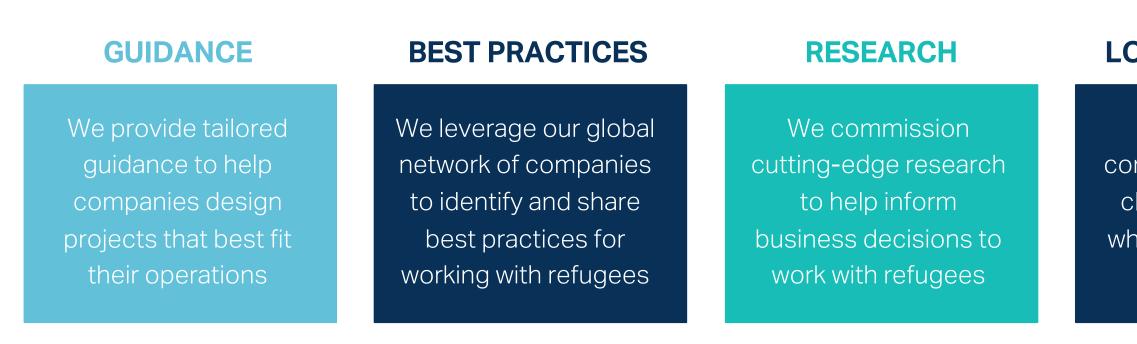

What is a refugee?

Refugee

A **refugee** is an individual who has been forced to flee their country because of a well-founded fear of persecution or violence.

Asylum Seeker

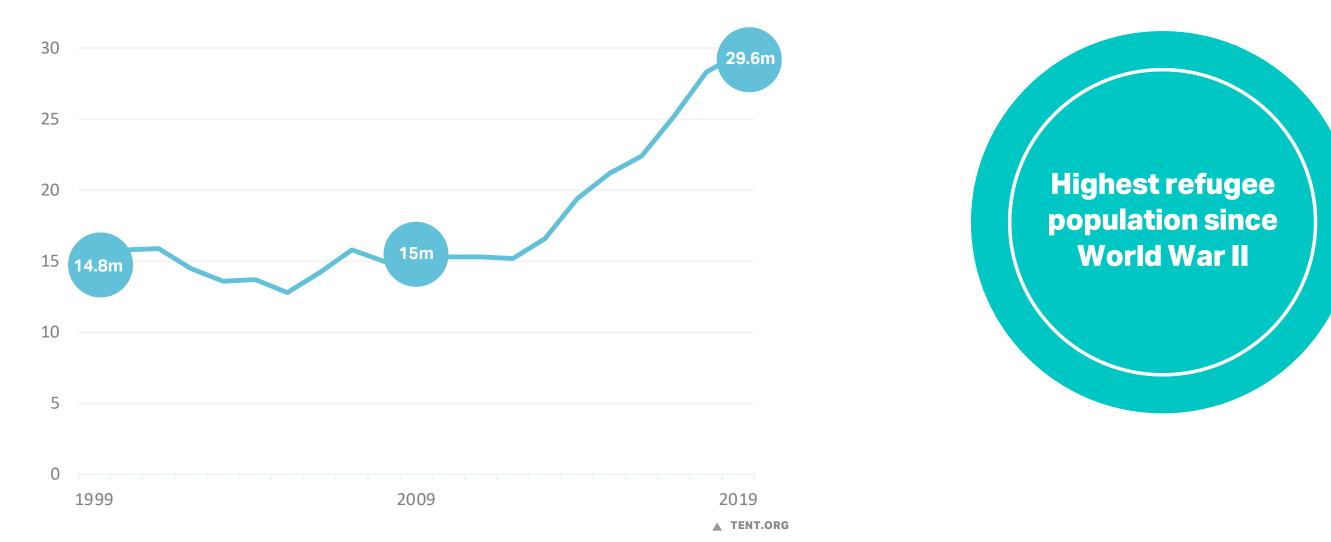
An **asylum seeker** is an individual who has left his/her country of origin and has formally applied for asylum in another country but is waiting for a determination.

Migrant

A **migrant** is someone who deliberately chooses to move to improve their life elsewhere.

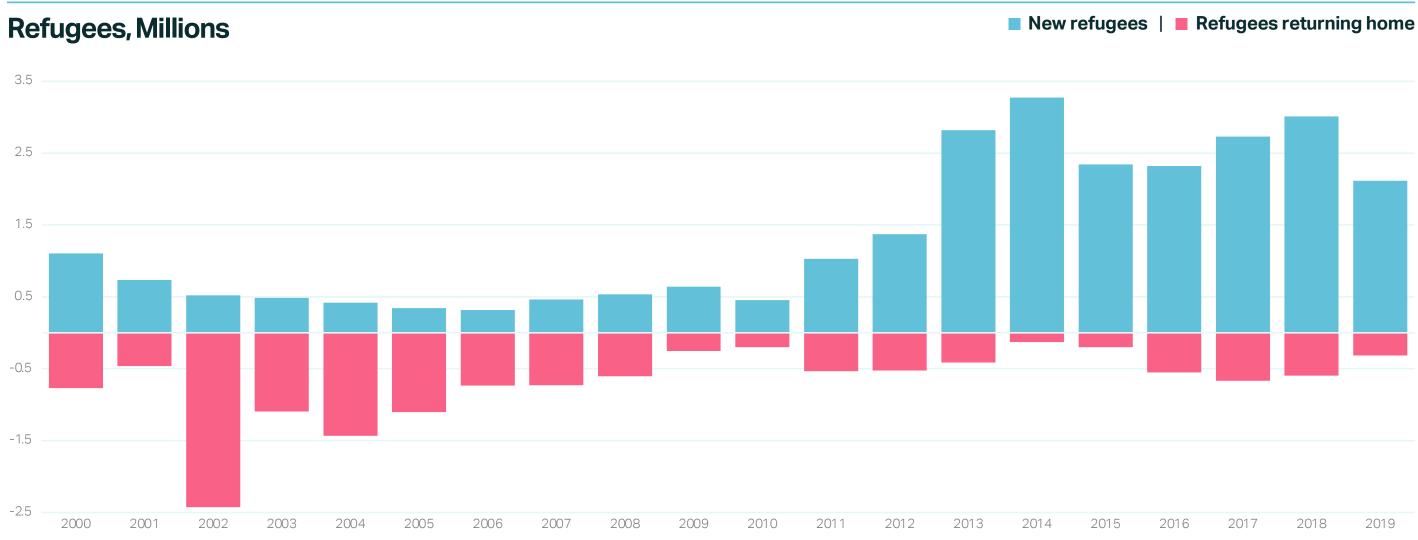
The global refugee population has increased rapidly over the last few years

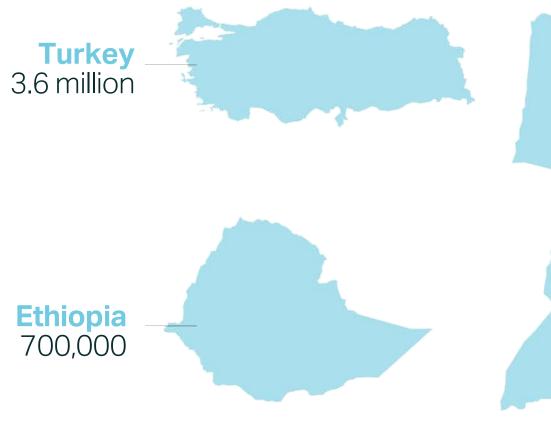

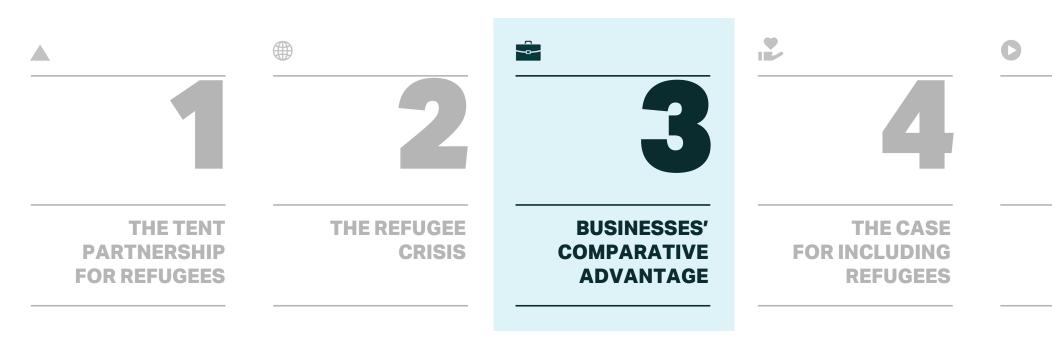

Examples of... **Hiring & Training**



Volkswagen has hired hundreds of refugees at its manufacturing plants in Germany



Barilla has committed to train and hire at least 75 additional refugees at its manufacturing plants and offices in Europe



IKEA has committed to provide 2,500 stores in 30 countries

Hilton

Hilton has hired 3,000 refugees in Germany and the United States

INDITEX

Inditex has trained and hired refugees in its stores, factories, and logistics centers; it has hired 100 refugees in Europe and Brazil to date

PHILIPS

Philips has committed to hire 100 refugees at its offices and manufacturing plants in the Netherlands and Germany

Examples of... Mentoring





Salesforce has developed a mentoring initiative connecting employees to refugees to help them find employment

Accenture employees have mentored 200 refugees in the Netherlands through an inperson six-month program



women employees







AT&T, Under Armour, and GSK, alongside 20 other companies, have each committed to mentoring at least 50 LGBTQ refugees in North America



EY has developed a program in the Netherlands for six months to mentor refugee women by EY's

H&M has committed to work with 40 supplier factories in Turkey to create jobs for at least 2,000 refugees



PayPal has encouraged its call-center provider in Brazil to hire Venezuelan refugees

TD Bank has launched an initiative to certify refugee-owned businesses in Canada, as a first step towards purchasing from these businesses

Examples of... **Supporting refugee entrepreneurs & small businesses**

Banca

Bancamía has committed to provide financial loans to 200 Venezuelan entrepreneurs in Colombia



Generali has committed to help 500 refugees in Europe start their own business by providing a 6-8-month incubation program



Ben & Jerry's has supported 175 refugee entrepreneurs in Europe through entrepreneurship training

facebook.

Facebook has committed to support 1,000 refugee entrepreneurs in Brazil by providing them with business sales training and advertising credits



Sobeys has helped refugee-owned businesses sell their products in its supermarkets, and helped with their warehousing and distribution

DoorDash has helped refugee-owned food businesses in North America by highlighting them on its platform and providing advisory services

Airbnb has committed to leverage its rental platform to provide housing to refugees in the short and medium term

LinkedIn has committed to provide 5,000 refugees with access to job mentorship and training



TELUS has launched a program to provide refugees in Canada with free smartphones and discounted mobile and home-internet plans



CIBC has made its financial products more accessible to refugees in Canada, reducing the requirements needed for credit cards



BNP Paribas has helped refugees open their bank accounts by adapting regulatory requirements and installing teller services in tobacco shops



Telefonica has committed to provide 10,000 Venezuelan refugees in Colombia with access to affordable telecommunications services



Businesses have the greatest impact when they see refugees not as victims, but as economically productive entrepreneurs, customers and workers



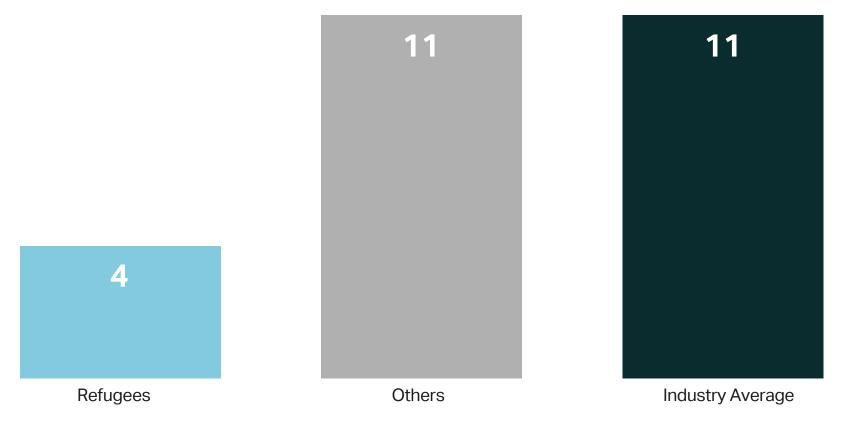

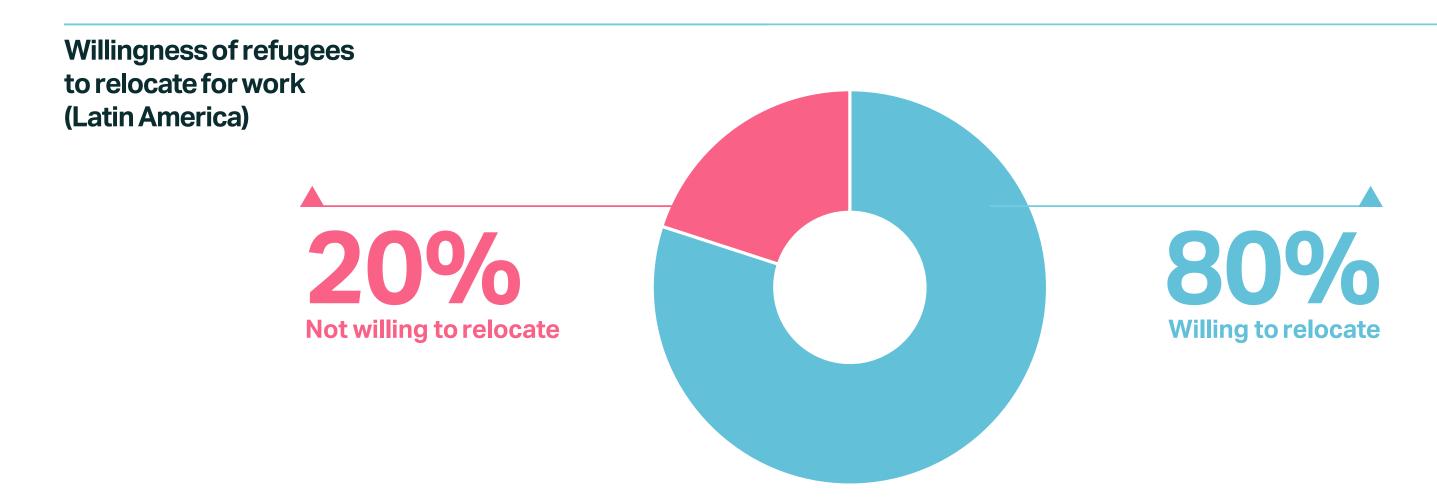

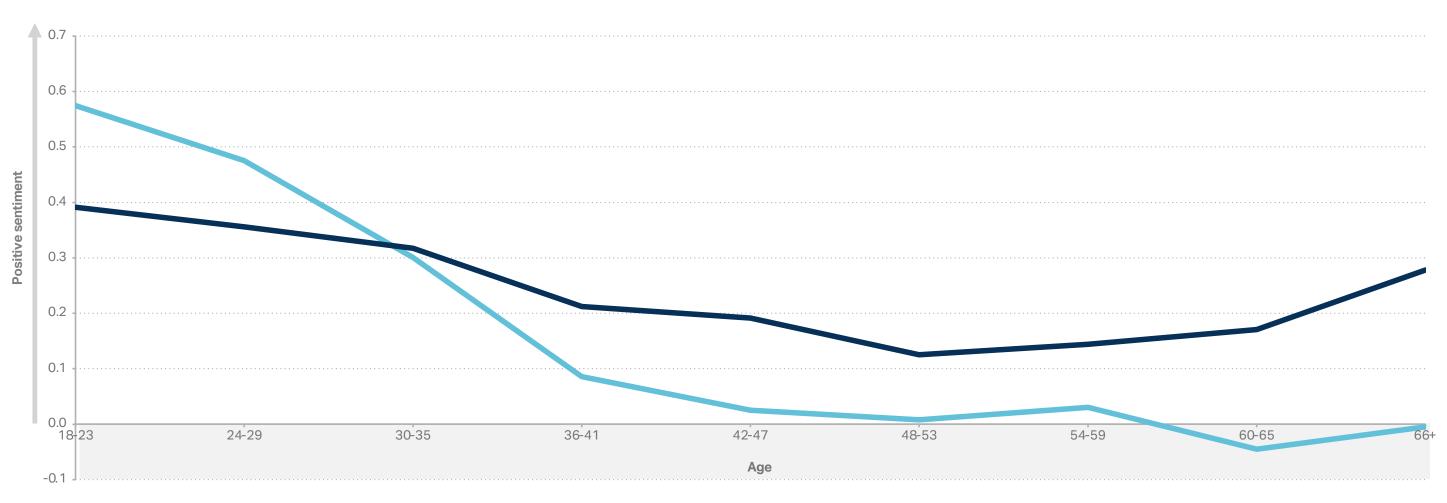


Refugees are more willing to relocate for work

Businesses can increase employee engagement

At least **80% of millennials** are more loyal to a company that helps them support social/environmental issues

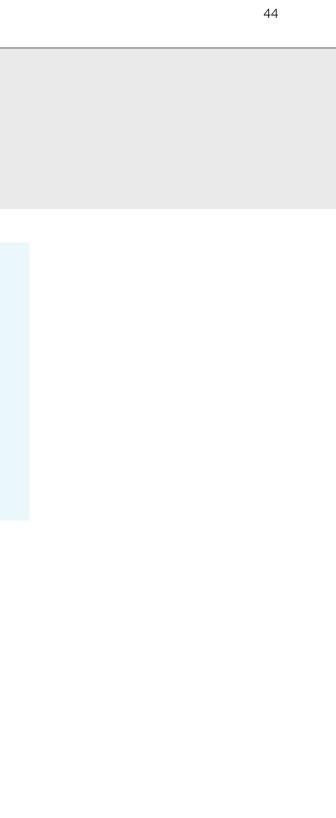
