



## **Job Title: Director of Partnerships for France**

### **Summary:**

The Tent Partnership for Refugees is significantly growing its team in Europe and is hiring for a Director to lead all of Tent's efforts in France, to be based in France. Tent is seeking a motivated and entrepreneurial candidate with 15+ years of corporate experience (including, but not limited to, business development, human resources, or sales). This candidate should have familiarity with business-led social impact programs, such as diversity and inclusion initiatives or projects to support under-served populations. No prior experience on refugee issues is required.

The Director of France will engage a broad range of leading businesses in France to encourage them to take steps to support refugees, as part of the Tent Partnership for Refugees, a global network of more than 220 major companies. The Director will provide hands-on support to companies to implement projects in support of refugees, including training and hiring refugees; identify and develop relationships with key nonprofits that can serve as implementation partners for companies on their refugee projects in France; and participate in and represent Tent at relevant workshops and conferences, as well as serve as a spokesperson for Tent to the French media. As it is safe to do so, the Director will be expected to travel within France and periodically outside of it (e.g. in Europe or to New York).

### **Responsibilities:**

- Encourage large companies in France to take practical steps to support refugees and to join the Tent Partnership global network
- Manage relationships with existing member companies in France and provide them with a range of services
- Convene companies to share best practices for hiring and integrating refugees in France
- Work with companies to help craft their commitments to integrate refugees in France
- Develop relationships with key partners and local organizations in France
- Represent Tent at conferences and external events, as well as to French media
- Build Tent's footprint in France

### **Requirements:**

- Fluent in French and proficient in English
- Ability to navigate French political and social contexts
- Experience working with multinational companies
- Proven track record in building and developing partnerships in the private and/or civil sector
- Bachelor's degree
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Strong presentation skills
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment and manage shifting priorities
- Comfort working independently
- Proficiency in MS Office Suite (especially powerpoint)
