About the role:

As a Web Developer & Content Specialist at Tent, you'll play a pivotal role in curating our digital presence, overseeing both front-end and back-end operations for our public site and Tent's Member's Hub. You'll lead the charge in creating and managing new pages, implementing updates during "milestone moments," and attending to daily content needs. Moreover, your expertise will be instrumental in orchestrating a potential rebuild of our Member's Hub, from research and recommendation to implementation of a content management system (CMS) or tailored solution aligned with Tent's objectives.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee both front-end and back-end development of Tent's public site, from new page/module construction to major updates and daily content upkeep
- Handle front-end and back-end tasks, including daily content management
- Assist in scoping and strategizing the potential rebuild of our Member's Hub site, exploring and implementing CMS solutions tailored to Tent's specific needs
- Manage limited back-end support from outside agency that supports in-house operations
- Enforce site standards, conduct QA through functional testing, content auditing, form creation, and ensure design, brand, and accessibility compliance
- Review and report back on website analytics to help optimize content and user experience

Additional duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Manage pro bono paid marketing grants and associated analytics, optimizing site performance via platforms like Google AdWords and LinkedIn ad grant
- Provide ad-hoc development support to other Tent software products aimed at helping member companies hire, mentor & train refugees
